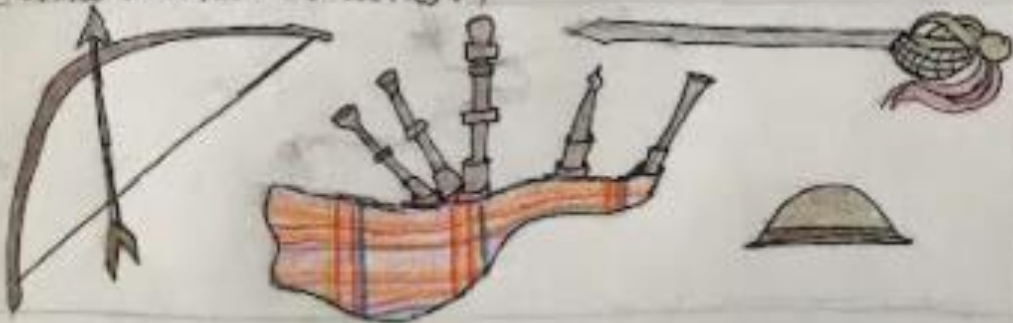


# Heroes of the World Wars

Jack Churchill - Bagpipe Swordsman

Born in 1906, Jack Churchill (no relation to the prime minister) went on to gain fame through his actions in WWII. His military career began when he served the 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion in India, in the year 1926. Upon returning to England, Churchill became a reserve officer and left to pursue a life of acting. He was called back to service at the start of WWII, where he quickly climbed the ranks. Churchill was known for leading his men from the front, as well as fighting with a sword and longbow. He also enjoyed playing the bagpipes to encourage his troops. Churchill eventually became a colonel and led a unit of commandos. Towards the end of the war, he was able to escape two enemy prison camps. Jack Churchill lived until the age of 89.
